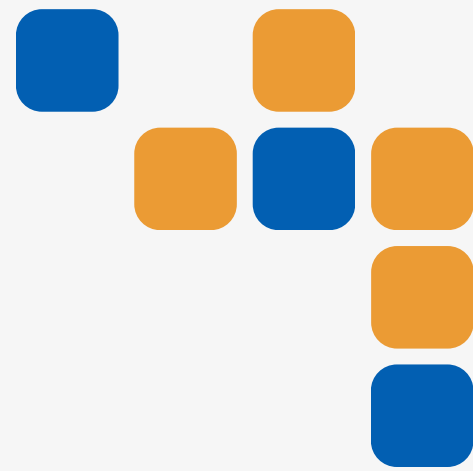

We are thrilled to host the **first training** of the **Edugame: Expansion** series under a **KA2 cooperation** project co-funded by the European Union. During this training course you will have an opportunity to learn how to use **4 educational games**, practice **facilitation** and gain initial understanding of **educational game design**. You will have an opportunity to apply gained knowledge and tools in practice in your work environment.

PARTICIPANT PROFILE

This activity is designed for **youth workers** and **educators** (high school teachers, youth trainers, camp leaders, ngo workers) and it is most beneficial for those who work directly with young people aged 14+ and who are interested in acquiring a deeper practical understanding of game-based learning.

Formal condition: The activity is open for residents of Estonia, Latvia, Slovakia, Portugal, Germany & Bulgaria. Participants have to be **over 18 years old** and able to follow the training course and work in English.

TRAVEL AND REIMBURSEMENT

When arranging tickets, bear in mind that there is a fixed maximum amount reimbursable for your **individual trip costs**. **Travel costs exceeding the maximum reimbursable amount will not be covered.**

Travel budgets according to each country

Portugal - 450 EUR

Latvia - 100 EUR

Slovakia, Bulgaria, Germany - 300 EUR

Reimbursement procedure

Reimbursements will be made **by bank transfer** to the organization or appointed responsible participant after all necessary **travel documentation and proof of dissemination activities** (facilitated game sessions) are sent to the hosts (we will make the transfer within 14 days from the moment we have everything needed from a country group).

Mandatory insurance

It is mandatory to have a **valid medical insurance** (i.e. European Health Insurance Card) during your travel and a **separate travel insurance** (must cover damage or loss of luggage, accidents and serious illness, death). It is the responsibility of each participant to provide proof of medical and travel insurance.

Arrivals, departures and extra days

Participants are requested to **arrive in Tallinn before 17:00** on **April 18** and **depart not earlier than 13:00 on April 22**. We expect everyone to book tickets according to the given times. At your own expense you can stay in the region up to 4 days before OR after the activity.

VENUE

The training will be organized in Tallinn. Accommodation will be provided in en-suite rooms of 2-3 people of the same gender and mixed countries in **Hestia Seaport Hotel Tallinn** (towels provided). Breakfast will be provided by the hotel, lunch by a catering service and dinners will be hosted outside in the city.



Practicalities

The sessions will take place in **Shokkin Group's Office space**, located 15-min walk away from the hotel. Please, bring indoor **shoes/socks/slippers** for the seminar room!

Make sure to bring any medication you might need during the week and a **personal water bottle**.

Pictures and videos taken during the activities might be used to document the training and promote the project in reports, partner websites, social media accounts and in further promotional materials.

For the benefit of the activity and in order to guarantee your **full involvement** in the experience, we ask selected participants **NOT TO PLAN** online meetings/appointments during the training time.
