



ERASMUS + PROGRAMME KA-153 – MOBILITY OF YOUTH WORKERS "DIGIBOX 3.0" Hosted by: Malta UNESCO Youth Association (MUYA)

A training course which aims to promote the use of digital tools and new media channels to increase operational capacity and effectiveness of youth organisations in the digital era.

Description:

"DIGIBOX 3.0" is a training course which will be organised by the Malta UNESCO Youth Association at Marsaxlokk Youth Activity Centre, Malta from the 24th of April to the 1st of May 2024 (7 working days 24/04 to 30/04 and 1 travel day) following the guidelines for 2022 of Key Action 1 -Mobility of youth workers, Erasmus+ programme of the European Commission.

Supported by trainers and support staff, this project will include 31 participants from 10 countries (Malta, Estonia, Austria, Slovenia, Kosovo, Latvia, Spain, Portugal, Germany and Sweden).

The ideal participant for the training course is envisioned as a full member of the partner organization. Additionally, she/he should have at least intermediate level of English, be in the age above 18 and hold a residency in the country participating in the project. Participants who are involved with their NGO Public Relations / Media / Marketing duties will be preferred.

Main Objectives:

- to discuss the current use of digital tools by organizations and analyze their potential to grow;
- to critically look at the threats and opportunities of online media as a discussion forum;
- raising awareness of how digital tools and new media can aid youth work and help to create greater impact of present-day youth activities;
- to develop competences of participants to become effective and versatile users of available digital tools;
- to create space for effective transfer of know-how in regards to media literacy and digitalization across Europe;
- to exchange tools, methods, ideas in the use of modern technologies across youth organizations in Europe;
- to foster European cooperation in the youth field and support the development of new innovative solutions for new generations of digitalized youth organizations;
- to update & spread a user-friendly collection of digital tools and promote it amongst youth organizations across Europe;

Venue:

Marsaxlokk Youth Activity Centre, St Francis Street, Marsaxlokk MXK, 1432, Malta

IMPORTANT Note: **Towels and Bed Linen will NOT be provided.** Participants will be distributed in twin or triple rooms.

Food:

Breakfast will be provided by host organisation.

Target group:

- Youth workers aged 18-30, leader can be 30+.
- Ideally, participants should be in a position of daily upkeeping the social media platforms for their NGOs.

Dates:

24th April – 1st of May 2024 (including arrival and departure dates).

Arrival day: 24th April, **LATEST 18:00.** Please contact me before purchasing your flights and wait for confirmation. A dinner will be served at 19:00, and a "Get to know each other" informal session will take place at 19:30. I would appreciate everyone being ready at the accommodation by that time. Departure day: 1st of May, **Between 8:00 and 12:00**.

Working Language:

English – It is imperative that all participants have good knowledge of English.

Costs:

Food, Lodging and educational costs are 100% covered by the Program.

Participation Fee from each participant: 25 Euro (will be deducted from re-imbursement) Travel Costs: 100% covered by the Program up to the limit indicated in the table for every participant from each country. Note: All receipts must be provided, including boarding passes for reimbursement to be submitted.

Weather:








How to get to venue:
